

"This is (your call sign) taking early check-ins before Monday night's net; anyone wishing to check in early, please give your call sign now." (Take check-ins)

"I copy:" (repeat check-ins heard, making sure the call signs are correct)

"Check-ins for the UHF & 220 repeaters will be done on 440 decimal 8 and 224 decimal 14, both with 100 Hertz tones. Please go to either of those frequencies now. This is (Your call sign); Thank you."

"Is this frequency clear?" "Hearing no objections - are there any Urgent or Emergency check-ins?" (Take check-ins & acknowledge check-ins.)

("None heard,") "This is (your call sign) taking check-ins on the UHF Repeater this Monday, the DATE of MONTH. Acknowledging early check-ins from:" (read off all early check-ins you received)

"Moving on to regular check-ins. Any & all stations with suffixes beginning with A through I, Alpha through India, please check in now." (Take check-ins)

"I copy:" (repeat check-ins heard, making sure the call signs are correct)

("Hearing none;") "Any & all stations with suffixes beginning A through P, Alpha through Papa, please check-in now." (Take check-ins)

"I copy:" (repeat check-ins heard, making sure the call signs are correct)

("Hearing none;") "Any & all stations with suffixes beginning A through Z, Alpha through Zulu, please check-in now." (Take check-ins)

"I copy:" (repeat check-ins heard, making sure the call signs are correct)

("Hearing none;") "Are there any missed or late check-ins, please check-in now." (Take check-ins)

"I copy:" (repeat check-ins heard, making sure the call signs are correct.)
(Count up total number of check-ins.)

"Myself included, we've had a total of ____ check-ins this evening. Thank you all, ladies & gentlemen for making your time & equipment available; & if you haven't already, please don't forget to check in with your main city net. This is (your call sign) switching back to the main net."

"Net Control, this is the UHF Repeater." (Wait for acknowledgement.)

"We had a total of ____ check-ins on the UHF Repeater. This is (your call sign) for the UHF Repeater. Thank you."
