

## 2019 SPECS Annual Meeting Minutes

Marc Roddin, KI6HLH, called the meeting to order near the appointed time, 0900. He introduced himself and stated that he would be termed out after this meeting. He then called on the various EC s in the room to introduce themselves and their ARES team members who were present.

Following this, Marc introduced Grant Elliot, KK6FMQ, as the current secretary and nominated incoming president. Grant first discussed the fact that the minutes were not on the website so the vote to approve them was delayed. Phil Henderson introduced Rob Fenn who spoke on parachute mobile. Ham radio operators Mark Meltzer, AF6IM, and Michael Gregg, KF6WRW, were chatting on a repeater in 2008 and learned that they shared skydiving as a second hobby. They talked further about combining the two hobbies and the Parachute Mobile Project was born. They have now had 33 missions and have put a lot of effort into getting live video from the jumper. Marc Roddin introduced Rachel Kinoshita, who's talk was entitled “Operating Off the Grid.” She spoke about the various kinds of solar arrays, inverters and specifically how the Menlo Park emergency trailer was configured to work on solar power. Her slides can be seen on the specsnet.org website.

After the talks, Grant Elliot held the business meeting where Scott Overstreet spoke about the repeaters and said that they were no closer to figuring out the interference problem on the 2 meter repeater but there is some hope that after the move the problem may go away. They also ping the hospital on the move about every month. Next the treasury was reported to be up ~\$1700 and Grant asked for a motion to approve and it was motioned and seconded and after that treasurer's report was approved unanimously.
